Support Ministries

Bereavement Ministry

For those who have experienced the loss of a loved one, we minister God's love and compassion to strengthen individuals during their time of sadness. Classes are six sessions, offered several times a year. Dates and times to be announced.

Care Ministry

Team members provide meals or part of a meal as needed for families of Victory in times of birth, illness, or a hospital stay.

Team Member Qualifications

Christians who are in places of responsibility in the church are required to be examples in faith, conduct, and business affairs. Maintaining a high standard for workers is one of the best ways to present Christ to the people of our community. Therefore, the following general guidelines will be required for any person who serves in the Ministry of Helps at Victory Family Church.

You must:

- Be in agreement with the tenets of faith of Victory.
- Be a member of Victory.
- Be able to make a minimum six-month commitment.
- Be loyal to the pastors and leaders of Victory.
- Be faithful to your assigned position.
- Live a separated Christian life.
- Attend ministry team and training sessions.
- Be faithful in attending regular church services.
- Be neat in your appearance.
- Keep your home life in order.
- Give thirty (30) days' notice when resigning position.
- Be available 30 minutes before and after scheduled service.

Ministry Team Members are needed to serve in various capacities in the following ministries:

Helps Ministries

Bookstore

The Living Word Bookstore provides team members the opportunity to sell, order, and stock faith-filled published media and a wide array of beautiful gifts in a retail environment. Retail experience helpful.

Camera Operators

Individuals are trained to use video equipment to shoot scheduled services, extra events such as water baptisms, and Victory advertisements to promote Victory's purpose.

Children's Ministry

Children's Ministry from nursery through grade 6 is available during all services and extended meetings. Opportunities for service include puppet ministry, costume characters, check-in attendants, classroom teachers and assistants, sound and lighting, and small tasks at the church.

Children's: Endless Possibilities (Special Needs)

Team members minister God's love and plan and coordinate care of the needs, strengths, and personalities of children who have special physical, medical, development or behavioral special needs. Individuals with a medical background are particularly needed, though all compassionate hearts are encouraged. Training is provided.

Event Photography

Team members take pictures of new members, special events & services.

First Impressions: Café

The café's full-service beverage bar needs team members to help in ordering, preparing, and selling an assortment of coffee, tea, juice, soda, and pastries. Training is provided.

First Impressions: Emergency Medical Team

Volunteer Doctors, RNs, or EMTs who will assist in the event of a medical emergency during service times. They will give the best First Aid possible under the circumstances and if needed, call 911.

First Impressions: Information Center and Media & Events Team

Information Center Team Members provide guests and church members with information regarding opportunities to serve, outreaches, special events, lost and found articles, selling of service tapes and CDs, and registration for upcoming events and seminars.

First Impressions: In-house Security

Security Team Members serve by monitoring hallways, restrooms, and other areas during services to facilitate the focus on God's message.

First Impressions: Traffic Team

This vital ministry supervises traffic flow so that vehicles can enter and exit the parking lot safely.

First Impressions: Ushers

Ushers serve in many capacities including collecting offerings, assisting with altar calls, serving communion, ministry lines, and serving the Body of Victory in special and regular services.

First Impressions: Welcoming Team

Ministry Team Members at the Information Center, at Communion, and as Welcoming Team, lead people into a growing relationship with Jesus Christ by welcoming, informing, and serving those who attend Victory's services.



Healing Team

The Healing Team equips believers to minister healing to those who are physically ill. Healing Team Ministry Members minister to individuals one-on-one and make hospital visitations. Participation in this ministry requires an intensive training program.

IT Ministry Team

IT Ministry is geared toward persons who are skilled in the various fields of Information Technologies. Responsibilities may include monitoring of the Children's Check-In workstations and kiosks before services, basic hardware/software support on PC and MAC workstations, and assisting with the design and update of the church's various web sites.

Media Duplication

Members of this ministry team prepare copies of messages for sale after each service, as well as for monthly mailings and special orders. Team members are also needed during regular office hours.

Office Team Members

This essential ministry enables the church to be a good steward of our resources. No technical skills are needed for tasks including: making copies, laminating, bulk mailing, computer work, phone calls, tape/CD duplicating, organizing, filing, and running errands. The office is open from 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Training is provided as required.

Prayer Partners

Prayer Partners share God's Word in order to build a foundation for faith so the born again have assurance, those who need restoration can make a fresh start, those seeking the baptism of the Holy Spirit can be filled, those who are sick can feel the healing power of God, and those with other needs can pray with a fellow believer.

Special Events Team

Special Events Team Members assist in setup and teardown before and after special events held at Victory. Heavy lifting may be required. Men preferred.

Spiritual Personal Trainers

Spiritual Personal Trainers is a mentoring program developed to help new Christians understand what took place at the new birth and how to begin to live their new lives in Christ. SPTs meet with participants and establish a solid, biblical foundation to help new believers succeed in life. Extensive training is required.

Student Ministries

Revolution Student Ministries has many opportunities for serving during both weekend and mid-week services in the information center, game room, prayer & altar team, usher/monitors, security, guest services, production, the café, and more.

Worship Team

This team includes audio/visual, music ministry, and sound ministry working together to enhance Victory's services.

Worship Team: Audio/Visual Ministry

The Audio/Visual ministry presents and coordinates media such as lyrics for songs, announcements, DVDs, and videos during each service.

Worship Team: Music Ministry

Vocalists and instrumentalists usher people into the presence of God through anointed praise and worship. Auditions are required. Training is provided.

Worship Team: Sound Ministry

Technicians serve the ministry and people of Victory by operating the sound system for all types of services. Training is provided.

Young Adults' Ministry (19north)

19north is for young adults, ages 18-30, and meets every Saturday at 8:30 p.m. This ministry addresses specific issues in the lives of young adults with relevance. Ministry Team Members are needed to aid 19north in several areas: setup and teardown, hospitality (preparing coffee and pastries), welcoming team, greeting team, info team, and follow-up team. Ministry Team members over the age of 30 are also welcomed.



Outreach Ministries

In Pursuit Adult Ministry

This group ministers to individuals ages 55 and older through planned activities and service projects. Meetings are held on the third Tuesday of each month from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. at Victory.

Pittsburgh School Project (LAMP)

Victory's 3-year partnership with Pittsburgh Learning Assistance and Mentoring Partnership (LAMP), a coalition of Pittsburgh public schools and area churches, serves student and school needs. Semester-long volunteers are needed to serve, tutor, support, and facilitate activities within these partnerships.

Victory Group (Addiction Recovery)

This outreach ministers in many ways to families & individuals in the community dealing with issues of addiction. Meetings are held every Tuesday from 7 – 8 p.m.
