1 WHAT IS _____ AND WHY WOULD I NEED IT?

- A. Salvation is the "saving [of] human beings from _____ and its consequences, which include _____ from God."
 - I. Think of something that could separate you from another person. Whether that be a wall, distance, death... You no longer have access to them. That's exactly what happens when we sin! It completely separates us having access to God.
- B. Romans 3:23 - "for _____ have sinned and fallen short of God's glorious standard"
 - I. Think of a time you've messed up and done something you shouldn't have (e.g.: lying, swearing, gossiping, hate, pride).
 - a. That qualifies us to face consequences and separation from God if NOT saved.

- A. Romans 10:9 - "If you _____ with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and _____ in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved".
- B. To confess simply means to _____ where you can hear it.
 - I. Example: Say your name out loud - You just confessed your name
 - II. To believe in your heart is to _____.
 - a. Example: What if I told you I am going to give you candy in small groups next week? The same way you can believe that, is the same way you can believe Christ died to save you! It's because He said it in His Word!

3 WHAT IF I HAVEN'T BEEN _____ COULD I STILL BE SAVED?

- A. Ephesians 2:8-9 - "For it is by _____ you have been saved, through _____—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—not by _____, so that no one can boast."
 - I. Grace - Underserved, unearned _____ of God.
 - II. Faith - the assurance of things hoped for, the confidence of things not seen.
 - a. To put it simply: Faith _____ what grace has made _____.
 - i. Example: If you receive a gift for your birthday, do you try to earn it before you take hold of it? No! You claim it as yours and receive it because it's a GIFT!
 - 1) It's the same with grace! Grace is a gift and faith just takes the gift made available!

Week 3: Share It

- A. Everyone has a story to share (don't overcomplicate it)
 - I. You were once DEAD in your sins, but now you are ALIVE in Christ.
 - II. You had a one-way ticket to hell, **but God** stepped in and took your place.
 - III. You were never capable of obtaining salvation from your own works (own good doing), but because of Christ's **work (the cross)** you were able to receive salvation by faith!
 - B. Questions we must ask ourselves:
 - I. If salvation is this good, how could I keep it all to myself?
 - II. Would I want someone to withhold this good news from me?
 - C. Who can you share your story with?
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- D. After you share your story, give someone the opportunity to have what you have!
 - I. How to lead someone into receiving salvation:
 - a. Ask them, "Would you want to say _____ to Jesus being the Lord of your life just like I did?"
 - i. **If they say yes**, lead them in the same prayer you received! This is where they confess with their mouth and believe in their heart, and they will be saved!
 - 1) Have them repeat after you, "Dear Jesus, I receive You into my heart and into my life. I declare You as my Lord. I am now a child of God. Thank You for saving me! In Jesus' name, amen!"
 - A) Let it come from your heart! It doesn't have to be the same prayer every time. Allow it to be a conversation with God.
 - 2) Celebrate them and congratulate them on making the best decision of their life!
 - ii. If they say ____, don't take it personally! Let them know you are always here if they change their mind!
